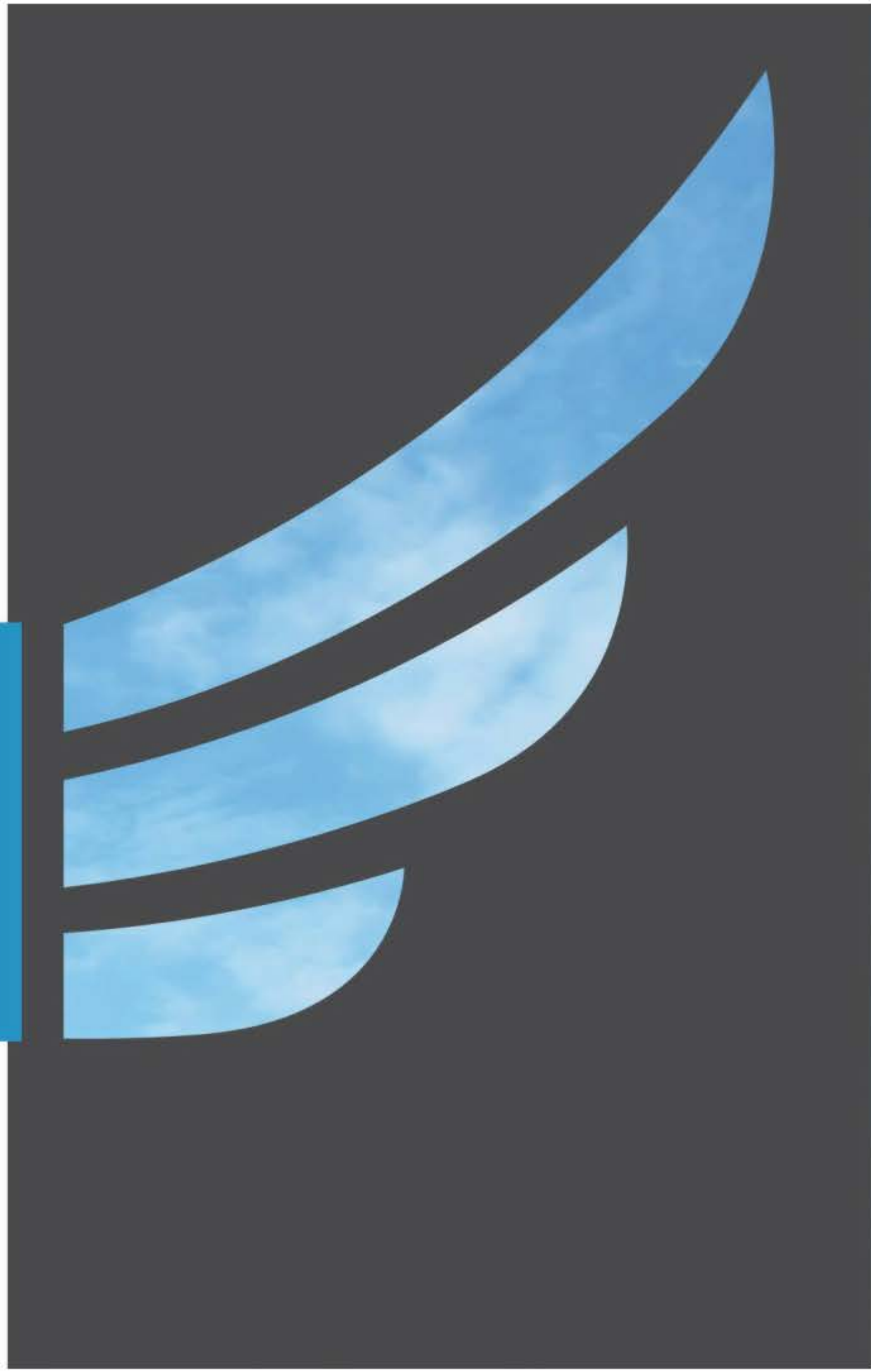

Airlift has been granted the approval of the Greek Civil Aviation Authority to operate commercial flights on various types of helicopters by its Air Operator Certificate (AOC). The company is also an authorized Aerial Work operator with significant experience in various projects.

Our fleet consists of the newest and most modern twin engine Airbus Helicopters, ensuring to provide the safest and most efficient service. As one of our main core value, our safety measures never cease to develop in order to maintain our high level of safety performance over time.

Airlift also operates its own Part 145 maintenance organization housed at owned facilities (technical base at Aspropyrgos, Attica), providing continuous airworthiness services for a wide range of helicopters through the Maintenance Organization Approval (AMO EASA PART-145) & Continuous Airworthiness Management Organization (CAMO EASA PART-M) certifications provided by the Greek Civil Aviation Authority.

AERIAL PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING

AIR AMBULANCE

One of the main activities of Airlift is to conduct medical flights, providing air transportation to stabilized patients according to the European and National legislation.

Our helicopters are converted into ambulance helicopters having the appropriate equipment that is essential for the air transportation of patients and take part in the air ambulance transfers across the country whenever its requested from sunrise to sunset, with first priority the safety of the patient.



CARGO OPERATIONS

Airlift has undertaken the transportation of internal and external cargo weighing up to 500 kg. The external load was transported using certified equipment (sling up to 10 meters).

Our well-trained flight crew and technical department, with its over the years' experience, had contributed effectively to the execution of the specific flights while observing all the safety rules according to the European and Greek legislation.



FIRE FIGHTING

The highly trained flight crew and technical department of our company, with the experience and the scientific knowledge it holds, has been involved in co-operation with the Fire Brigade in the successful extinguishing of fires like the ones of Chios Island.



OUR TECHNICAL BASE

Helicopter maintenance is a major part of Airlift's business. Helicopter operators are well aware of the real costs of equipment ownership. As an EASA Approved Maintenance Station and Approved Airbus Service Facility, Airlift can provide professional and quality service in its owned facilities.

AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE

Airlift through its maintenance base at Aspropyrgos, Attica has been certified under EASA Part-145 (by the Civil Aviation Authority). It can meet inspection, maintenance and repair needs for a wide and constantly growing range of aircraft types.

All of the company's administrative staff are highly trained professionals and have a long-lasting experience in helicopters. The technical staff has been certified under EASA Part-66 and can perform all the required line and base maintenance works.
